Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to announce that on **Tuesday 26th September** we will be celebrating the **European Day of Languages**. This is an annual event which has been celebrating linguistic and cultural diversity for the past 20 years.

As a school we are committed to offering a broad and balanced curriculum which provides children with an awareness of the world around them and an understanding of themselves as global citizens. Throughout the day, the children will have an opportunity to learn about some of the European languages and celebrate different languages and cultures.

Across the nursery and school, we will be focussing on four different European Languages- Spanish, French, German, and Italian. As part of the day, we ask that, where possible, **children come dressed in colours representing the flag of a country where their language is spoken.**

Nursery - Spanish (Red & Yellow)
Reception, Years 1 and 5 - French (Red, White & Blue)
Years 2 and 3 – German (Black, Red & Yellow)
Years 4 and 6 – Italian (Red, White & Green)

During the day, the children will have opportunity to listen to music in the foreign language, try some food associated with the different countries and greet their peers in their language too. If your child has any **allergy** or **dietary concerns** which you feel we should be aware of, **please speak to their class teacher.**

We are really excited to be taking part in European Day of Languages again and are looking forward to celebrating some of the different languages and cultures from across the continent.
