Superheroes

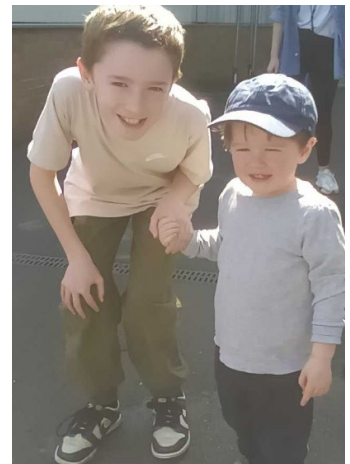

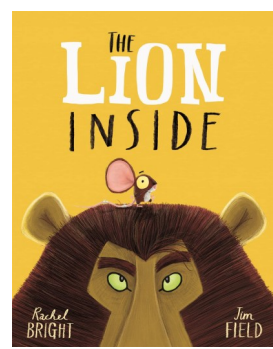
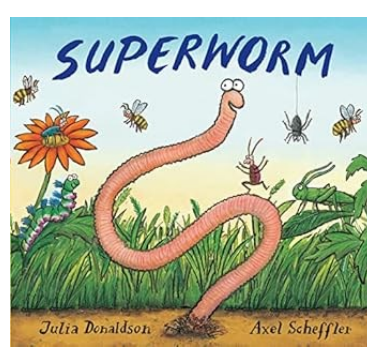
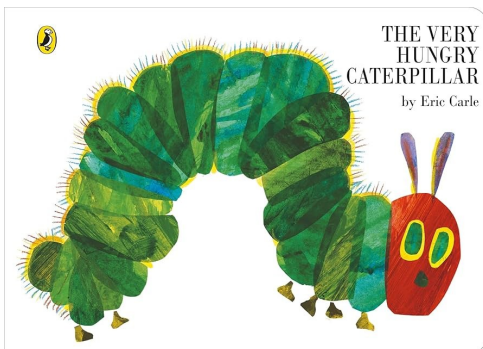
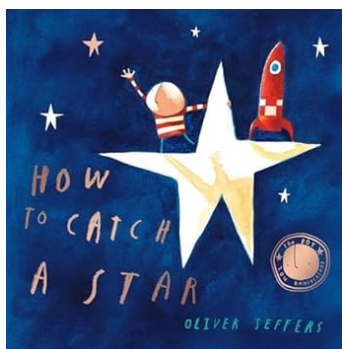
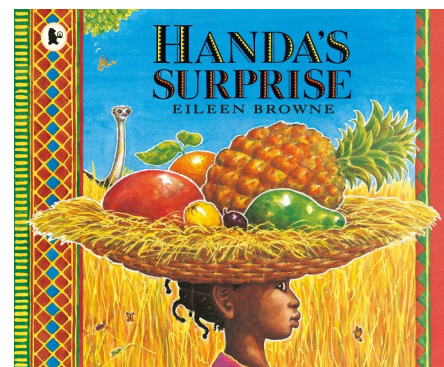
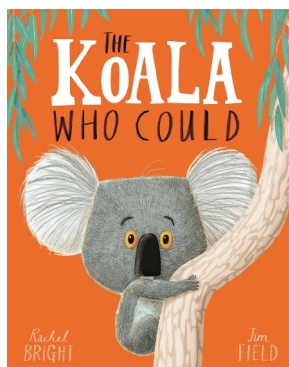
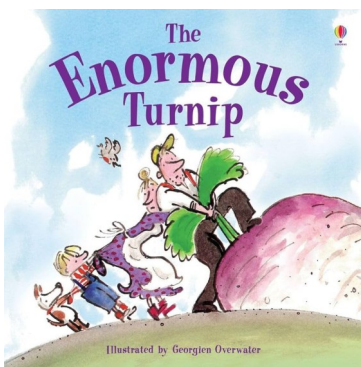
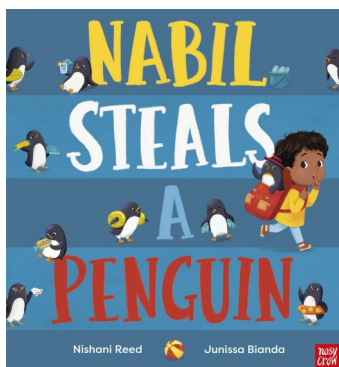
Pete the Poet
