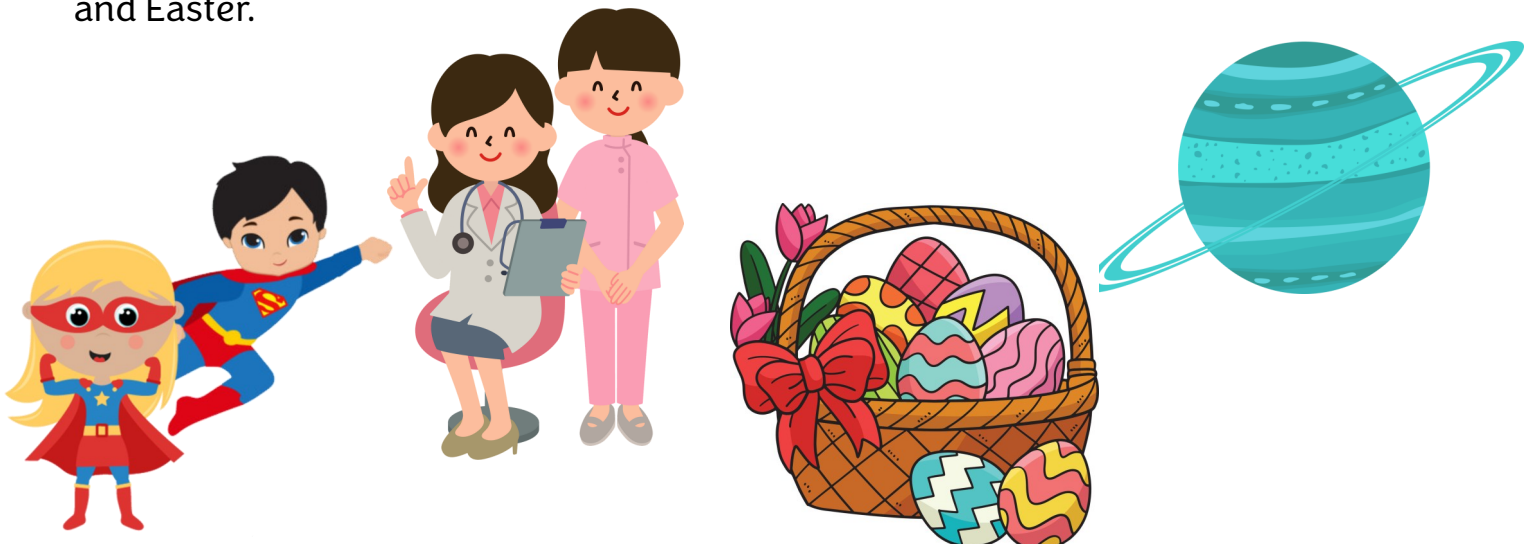

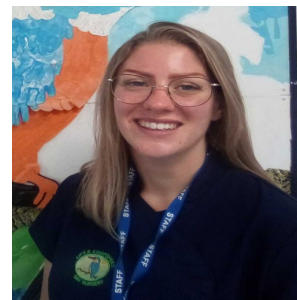

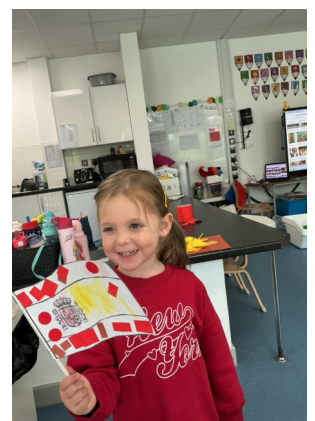
Remembrance Day

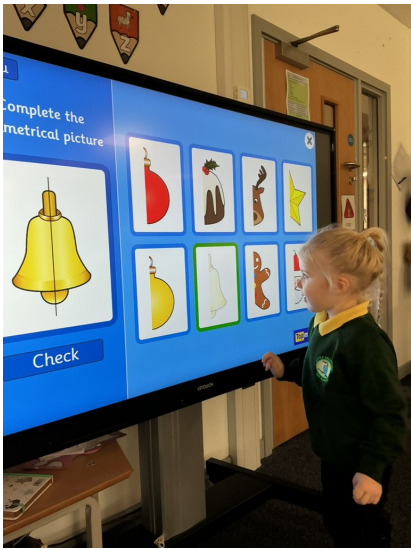
Children in Need
